

PROPORTION


The relationship between objects in a work of art, how they compare to each other and the art as a whole.

Good **proportion** creates HARMONY and BALANCE in a work of art.


The GOLDEN RATIO is a mathematical ratio commonly found in nature, the ratio of 1 to 1.618, that when used in art and design is more appealing to the eye.



The GOLDEN RATIO is created by taking a rectangle, adding a square inside and another rectangle. This pattern can infinitely repeat inside the original rectangle.



The GOLDEN SPIRAL can also be used to show good **proportion**.




Add the GOLDEN RECTANGLE over your artwork, place the

focal point in one of the thirds. This will create a BALANCED

composition with strong proportion.

In addition to laying out your work of art, **proportion** can refer to the relationship between the objects in the work of art.




Standard Proportion: objects appear to be the correct size in

objects appear to be the correct size in comparison to it's surroundings. Artwork can have standard proportion or altered proportion.

Altered Proportion:

proportions of objects have been changed, or appear unrealistic.
